It began with mid-winter Makers' Sessions, first using brown shipping paper layouts, then cut patterns, than hand painting and sewing of four Garden Wall Hangings that illustrate four lines from Dorothy Frances Gurney's lovely poem, "God's Garden." The poem was originally written in Lord Ronald Gower's visitor's book. It was inspired by his exquisite garden at Hammersfield Penshurst according to a copy handwritten in England on an envelope (c. 1925) found in a book on the Church of England's Liberal Evangelicals in 2010. And no wonder the poet was so inspired. The Penshurst Gardens in Kent, in the Southeast of England, are simply stunning. The Gardens are one of the oldest privately owned in the world, dating back to 1341 in English History, still providing peace and comfort to global visitors and garden-lovers in the 21st century.
