When I was young and in confirmation I think I was encouraged to study the Bible but I was always given the impression that there was one answer to any conversations that we were having. The first time I taught confirmation, it was important to me to find ways to prioritize questions and wondering and creative thinking.

Confirmation is a ritual into adulthood-ish. It is an opportunity for young people to take seriously what they believe and how they can participate in the life of the church. While the service of Confirmation happens at the end of a school year, it is not a graduation but one step on a lifelong journey of learning and growing in community.

For the last 2 years, four of our young people have been meeting outside or inside, sometimes distanced and masked. We had conversations about the Bible, church, friends, faith, and life. The conversations were thoughtful, insightful, and funny.

The last 2 years of confirmation were not what we had hoped they would be, but I appreciate the confirmation students and their families for their flexibility and willingness to roll with the changes as they came up and their commitment to the time together. This year's Confirmation Class...

Remembering Judy Stanek



Saying goodbye never gets easier. In April Judy contracted a staph infection that she could not overcome and passed away on April 25, leaving behind a family that loved her along with many, many friends both here at Emmanuel and in the community.

Judy and her husband, Ferd settled in Dousman following Ferd's retirement from the U.S.

Navy. They brought with them their two children, Lisa and Matt. The Staneks began attending Emmanuel so that their children could go to Sunday School and soon followed suit themselves, becoming members on June 12, 1983.

Judy was an active member, serving multiple terms on the Board of Deacons, singing in the choir, delivering meals on wheels, being the secretary for our rebate programs through Pick n Save and Sentry, as well as participating in the book club and attending a number of adult retreats. She was a member of the local Dousman area homemakers club for many years. She was also a thoughtful caretaker. Both Ferd's father and later Judy's mother came to live with them as their health failed in later years.

Judy LOVED her family and her grandsons, Eric and Jake. She would light up any time she spoke of them. She loved to travel to Colorado to visit Matt, his wife, Marin and the boys, usually at least twice a year while Ferd's health allowed it.

When Alzheimer's Disease became a problem for Ferd, they sold their house in Dousman and moved to the Three Pillars Compass Point Assisted Living. Later, Ferd's condition necessitated his moving to the Health Care Center and eventually, Judy made that same move.

Judy lost her beloved husband of 52 years in August of 2017. She missed Ferd terribly, but Judy was not one to get down and stay there. Despite her circumstances or her own failing health, she was rarely in a down mood. She had the wonderful ability to accept her circumstances and be grateful for what she had. Every two years, family from all around the country would gather for a Christmas celebration. In recent years, these gatherings took place in the Dousman area because Judy and Ferd and then just Judy could not travel. The most recent celebration took place in December 2021. Judy always LOVED these occasions.

Judy Stanek was a treasured friend to many of us. She and Lorna Marheine were as close as sisters. Judy made the world a better place to be. Rest in peace lovely lady.
